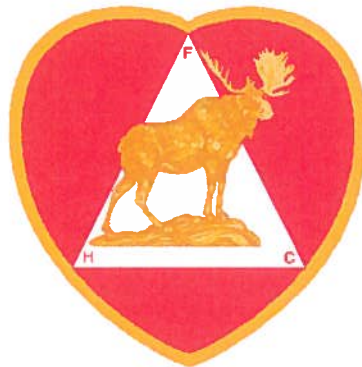
WOMEN OF THE MOOSE

MOOSE RIDERS

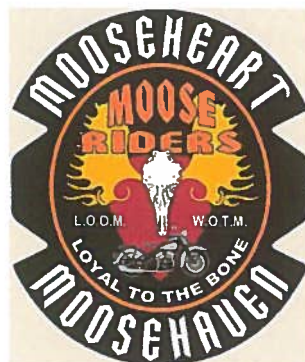
The Moose Riders will be serving “beer can” chicken for the Friday night meal on September 9th.
