MOOSEHEART is a residential childcare facility, located on a 1,000-acre campus 38 miles west of Chicago. The Child City is a home for children and teens in need, from infancy through high school. Dedicated in July 1913 by the Moose fraternal organization,

MOOSEHEART cares for youth whose families are unable, for a wide variety of reasons, to care for them. Some have lost one or both parents; others are living in environments that are simply not conducive to healthy growth and development. Whatever the reason, the men and women of the Moose, through unparalleled generosity and volunteerism, furnish the resources necessary to care for children in need. The Moose fraternity provides children with a wholesome home-like environment and the best possible training and education.

Children live in one of thirty <u>residences</u> designed like a spacious single-family residence. Each is home for six to twelve children. The heart of the program is Family Teachers — providing a consistent, systematic method of care, with emphasis on social-skills development — skills essential for success in later life. It is Mooseheart's policy to admit qualified children who have a need. The Admissions Committee considers all applications of children.

This is just 1 of the reasons we do what we do. We need your help to spread the word of Moose. Our Membership in the fraternity is shrinking and we are the only ones that can stop it. We as members took an oath to increase the membership. Every penny is spent to help our children and seniors. We need you to sign up new and former members Plus if you know of anyone that hasn't paid their dues ask them to and tell them how their small amount of money helps children.




Moose Riders


MOOSE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION—JULY 1-5, 2016

TOMMY MOOSE PROGRAM



Shoparoo gives money to schools for pictures of receipts.

Upload the Shoparoo app to your Smartphone. The app is free.
